With a higher percentage of silica, bamboo supports collagen production, resulting in a more glowing and healthier skin appearance, improved skin elasticity, strengthened bones, increased connective tissue, and enhanced overall joint flexibility. It also assists in preventing hair thinning, promotes hair growth, alleviates eczema and psoriasis, improves hair condition and luster, and protects and strengthens nails.
